ADDITIONAL LEARNING FEES

- Diagnosed students confirmed as requiring Additional Educational Needs support pay a supplementary fee of 30% on top of their tuition fees if requiring a fully modified curriculum in one or more subjects. As appropriate, individual Assessment Fees of JD 175 for KG 1 – KG 2 students and JD 325 for students in Grades 1 – 9 (or JD 75 Scotopic Sensitivity Syndrome (SSS)), are also charged for comprehensive educational assessments and reports.
- 2. International Section students from Grade 6 to Grade 10 requiring Arabic Language Support additional to the standard curriculum pay a supplemental fee of 30% on top of their tuition fees. The International Section Fee includes Additional Educational Needs support, if required as confirmed through diagnosis.

OTHER ITEMS

Ministry textbooks and stationery items are supplied by the School. The costs of other textbooks (including international titles), examination fees, field trips, special courses, or university entrance fees, co-curricular activities and Summer School Activities are payable separately.

SCHOOL CAFETERIAS:

A price list of menu items is published on the school website, subject to change from time to time, per review and endorsement by the School Catering Committee.

PAYMENT OF FEES:

Fees are due by March 31, 2023 for existing parents or within one week of acceptance for new entrants, and are payable in one of two ways:

- a) Payment of total annual fee in advance by 31 March 2023 or within one week of acceptance, or
- b) By three (3) post-dated cheque in equal amounts, dated: 31 March 2023, 30 September 2023, and 31 January 2024, or within one week of acceptance.
- c) Payment of total annual fees in full in advance by using a Etihad Bank Visa credit card. This will be interest free and the bank will deduct the installments in 12 equal monthly deductions. Please also note that the amount will be subject to a 1.85% commission charge paid to the Visa company
 - If payment in full or by post-dated cheques is not received by the due date, the school reserves the right to accept new students from the waiting list in place of existing students.

NOTIFICATION OF WITHDRAWAL:

Written notice of withdrawal must be given before the due date of the first payment to avoid penalty charges. One month's fee (calculated as 1/9 of the tuition fee) will be due for each month or partial month of notice not given, starting from the due date of the first payment.
